After the chaos, here's yer list of over 700 groups, organisations, zines, websites, people and places...

Most of the entries have been checked March to May 2000, with the descriptions usually written by the people themselves. This year web addresses have been included too. There are links on the SchNEWS website, where the full list also appears. International phone numbers often don't have the country's code included, so check in the phone book. SAE means send a stamped, self-addressed envelope. To make life easier we've included both an alphabetical list, where all the details appear, and a list sorted by categories, where only the organisation's name appears.

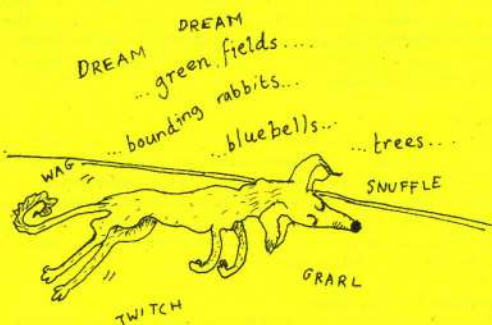

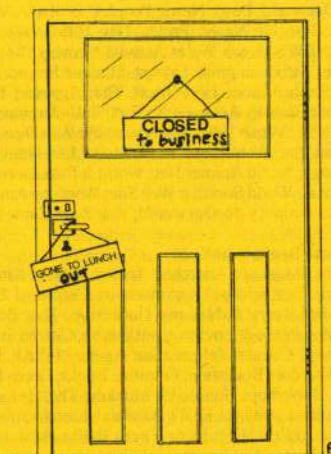
