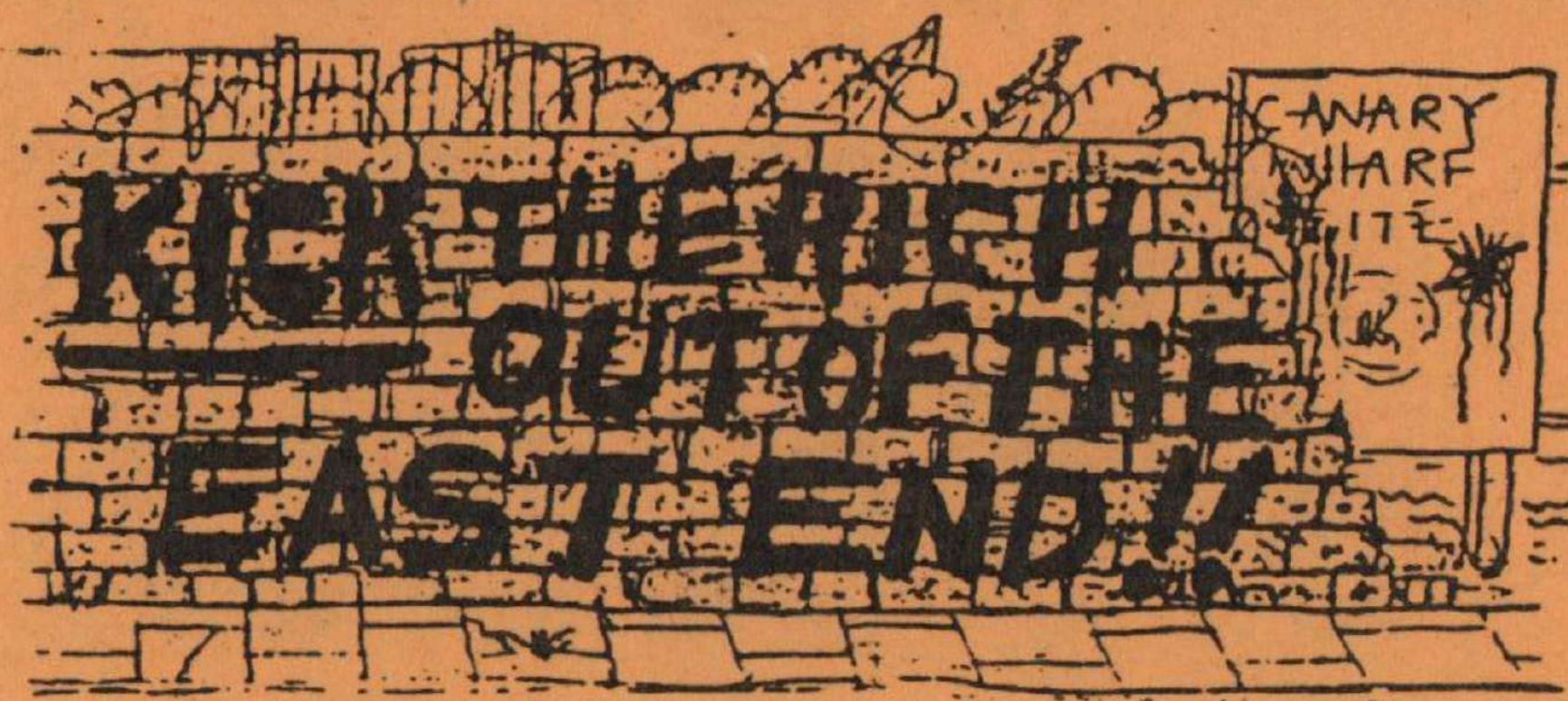




ANGER OVER MARATHON

Anger and frustration on the Island are at an all-time high, over the total lack of consideration for the original community and their livelihoods.

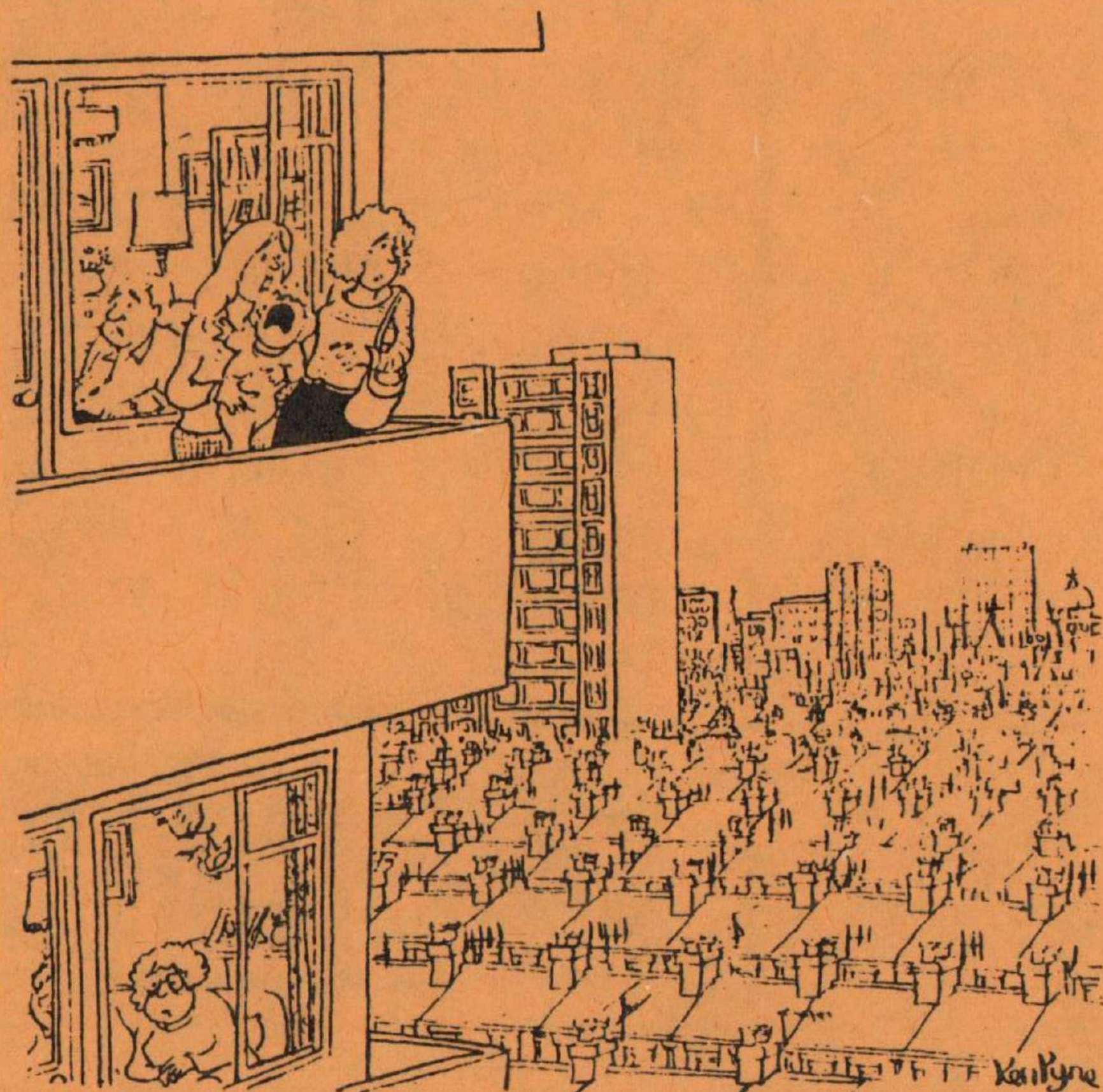
