

POLICE BATTLE SQUATTERS CLASS STRUGGLE? ON LOWER EAST SIDE (OF BERLIN)

November 14, when 1500 heavily armed police with tear gas and water cannons were sent to clear street of 10 squatted houses in the working class (former) East Berlin district of Friedrichshain. Squatters fought back valiantly against the police with cobblestones and gasoline bombs. But to no avail as by nightfall the community had been evicted and 370 squatter and supporters jailed. The over 75 injured cops should at least attest to their determination!

Solidarity with the squatters has been shown in incredible amounts. A march on November 18, with an estimated 6000 or more participants, was one of a series demanding an end to the crack-down and the return of evicted squats. The squat crack-

Behind The Numbers

Theft in the workplace is commonly estimated to cost between \$30 billion and \$40 billion a year in the United States. That is in cash, goods and property.

These figures are based on a 1975 report by the American Management Association in New York, which judged the loss as due to these 11 "nonviolent crimes": employee pifferage, kickbacks or bribery, security theft and fraud embezzlement, arson, burglary, vandalism, shoplifting, insurance fraud, check fraud, and credit-card fraud.

What's more, there are employee behaviors labeled "intangible crime" by the U.S. Chamber of Commerce or "time theft" by Robert Half International, headquartered in Menlo Park, Calif. Robert Half estimates that time theft costs U.S. businesses \$230 billion a year. These crimes cover the fake sick day, getting someone else to punch in your card on the time clock, making personal telephone calls, conducting private business in the workplace. There is tremendous argument over whether unauthorized telephone calls to home or any of these other activities should be toted as part of theft loss.

THE CLASS SYSTEM

We live in a bitterly divided class society. The working class and the ruling class make up this society. The working class, who comprise the cast majority of the population, are forced to sell their labor and brains to meet their basic needs; food, housing, clothing, etc. The wages we earn are but a mere fraction of what we produce for the bosses of the ruling class. Workers may be able to make 20 or 30 television sets each week, but their wages will only allow them to buy just one, if that! This is one simple example of capitalism. We produce the wealth, not for ourselves, but for the ruling class, who reinvest this wealth back into banks, machinery, raw materials, etc. and ultimately into the luxurious lifestyles they are able to lead. This keeps the cycle of capitalism rolling -- always benefitting the ruling

This tiny elite, the ruling class, made up of the most revolting blood-suckers such as politicians, church leaders, managing directors, top cops, generals, etc. own and control everything. They have the money the land and the power. The state--Governments, police, army, schools, prisons, media, etc. (though it may seem to occasionally work against capitalism) keeps the process in order and crushes those who dare to resist.

We can not expect real change to come through Congress, just

as we cannot expect real justice through the courts. These institutions were set up and the rules made by the ruling class, to protect their own interests and control working class anger.

DIVIDE AND RULE

What the capitalists fear most is the working class uniting against them. They prevent this by erecting artificial barriers and deliberately foster ideas based on ignorance such as racism, sexism and homophobia. When it comes to housing we are told to blame the Asian family on the corner, not the capitalist who owns three or four houses, each costing hundreds of thousands of dollars. When companies lay off workers, and unemployment rises, we're told to blame the Blacks, women workers, or the unions -- not the bosses who can over-night lay off thousands of workers. White against blacks, women against men, heterosexuals against gays,

GOT NO CLASS?

Attempts have been made to say that a class is a thing of the past. Read a copy of the Post and you'll see such trash as "We're all middle class now" apparently because we have a VCR or color TV. We may now be able to attord a video recorder, after slaving away in the crummy office or stinking factory for years, but the power and the wealth stays firmly in the hands of the capitalists.
