GENERAL QUATERLY CONFERENCE:-

Keele Student Union Building, 23/24th March. Starts 10a.m. sharp. If you arrive on Friday evening there should be a Miners Benefit on at Newcastle Guildhall (circled in red on the Map enclosed). If for any reason this is cancelled we shall meet in the 'BULLS VAULTS' pub, opposite the Bus station (follow the red arrow on Map).
