OSLO - BLITZ TO BE CLEARED!

After years of talk and threats, at 10-1-1990 the local Council in Oslo decided that the youth-house Blitz must be cleared, the people who uses the house must be out at the latest 1. of march. After this decision was made, about 1000 people showed up around Blitz. Barrikades are being improved and Blitz is getting ready to defend itself. From Hamburg and Frankfurt there has been reports of solidarity-actions with Blitz. As a part of the mobilisation for Blitz there will be a big demonstration 25-1 against the Southafrican Consulate, which has been moved back to the city again. Formally, the eviction has not really been passed in the Local Council yet - as this decision needs a 2/3 majority. But that majority seems to become a reality at the Council-meeting at 24-1.

"THE BIG TERROR CASE"

The situation has not changed very much since we last reported on this case. Now - January 1990 - 19 people are charged, 7 of them are in solitary-prison (5 has been for more than 9 months), and they still keep absolutely silent. The charges involve killing of a policeman, robbery, violence, illegal possession of weapons, planning of kidnapping, attempt to steal weapons in Norway - and the terror-§, § 114, because the group sent their robbed money to a "terrorist-organisation", the palestinian organization, PFLP. The police still leaks the info they want the public to know, the arrested say nothing at all, their lawyers are not allowed to say anything. The cop in head of the investigation had to resign from this job, because he was seen discussing the case with some journalists at a bar in Copenhagen. In short time the police will decide who to charge with what, they still hope someone will start talking. As no confessions are made, the case will be with a jury, and it might come to court this spring.

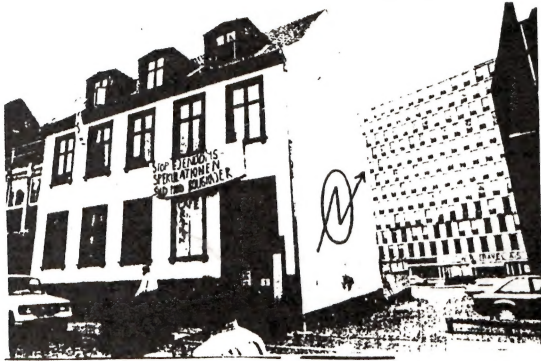
"TRAVEL SOUTH AFRICA '90"

NEW MAGAZINE

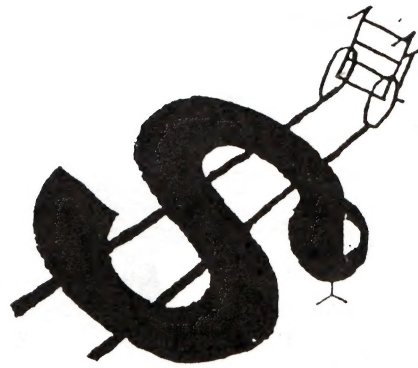

Mindegade 7 has been squatted for nearly 9 months now. The owner of the house got his permission to build offices from Local council in november, but he still hasn't asked the police to evict the squatters. So, the situation for the squatters is again - waiting. Meanwhile, about 15 persons live in the squat, they run a cafe 2-3 times a week, with film or music, cheap food etc. And in the autumn the squatters have started up "common meetings" where all "BZ-like characters" in Århus are welcome to discuss, exchange ideas, tell news etc. That is every second sunday, at 15⁰⁰ afternoon, at Mindegade 7, 8000 Århus C.



HEALTH - FOR THOSE WHO CAN PAY

The first private (pay-) hospital in Denmark was opened at 2-10, and at the same time & place an organisation "Equal Right to Health" made a symbolic burial of The Public Health System, as a protest against the privatization. They fear that the luxury private hospital will be only for the rich (those who can afford the payment or whose employer are willing to buy an insurance...) at the same time it will drain money and other resources from the public system (education of doctors & nurses; and they must have blood from the public hospital etc.) Also the politicians will surely use the private hospital as an excuse for more cutting downs on the public ones. Just look at England or USA to see how bad it can be how long you can get away from equal right to health! Speeches at the burial called for a boycott of the capital-interests behind mostly the insurance-company Hafnia and cleaning- and security company ISS.

SOCIALISTIC YOUTH GATHERING

was held in Slagelse at oct. 7-8, about 200 young people from leftwing parties and organizations, BZ, Youth Against Apartheid and others, discussed EEC-union, social cutting, racism etc. The gathering will continue with "Parliament of the Street" in the various towns, and in 1990 a new Gathering will be held.

The first actions were held in november, street-theatre etc. And also the first splinter has occurred as BZ in Copenhagen has left the local Gadens Parlament, in protest against another participant. So it seems like yet another common-initiative has stopped being common before it has really started.... at least in Copenhagen, hopefully the rest of the groups can continue their cooperation.

NORTHERN LIGHTS - WOMEN'S ACTION
- an invitation to all women, to participate in a pronounced protest against the ongoing armament of the North.

In September 1990 NATO will again carry out a big war-exercise in Norway. The TEAM WORK exercise will involve soldiers from USA, England, Holland and Norway - the biggest exercise in Norway this year. The part carried out on land near Trondheim, will involve 18.000 soldiers.

We, Nordiske Kvinders Fredsnettverk (Nordic Womens Peace-network, an informal network of women involved in peace-work) will try to stop the exercise. First the "parliamentary way" will be tried: by public discussion and demands try to get the exercise stopped, by the NATO heads themselves. And if this is no success, then we will try to stop them at the spot, with nonviolent actions.

The Network is also protesting an exercise, Array encounter, carried out feb. 15-28, near Tromsø. Tromsø is a heavily militarized area in Norway -every year exercises with 10.000-15.000 men, and many installations like radar, runways, army-hospitals, etc etc are even being enlarged. The local population. The local population are getting more and more dependent on the military economy, because the area has high unemployment and also problems with "black sea", that is: no fishing. Unfortunately there is not time enough to prepare an action, but letters of protest etc will be sendt.

To make the actions against TEAM WORK many women are needed! Both in the planning and in the actions - if you are interested, you can contact Tine Forchhemmer, Løjenkærvej 28, 8300 Odder, Denmark. It should be before March 5., because long time will be needed, to make the affinity- and local groups work well before the actions must be carried out. FINNISH TREE-HUG'ERS

(Tree-hug'ers are activists fighting to protect forests. They often action by chaining themselves to the threatened trees - like hugging the trees...)

The local population in Vuolokjoki in north Finland have risen against the Finnish Forest Authorities' cutting of nearly 2000 ha of forest in their area. The activists demand a 10 year old decision to be changed, and the area of the forest to be protected area. The Church urges its Community-members to vil obedience, and police have been used against the tree-hug'ers.

"STOP POLICE VIOLENCE

Friday 16-10 police attacked a legal BZ-demonstration in Copenhagen. Repression in form of telephone bugging, opening of mail, solitary prison etc is everyday life for us, who want to fight the system. That shows us that the highly praised danish democracy is rotten when it comes to Right to Speak and to demonstrate.

Banks and the legal system are parts of the System, which is protected by cops with their long batons.

Because of that, in solidarity with BZ-Copenhagen, we have tonight smashed windows in 2 banks in Århus, and graffitied the Court-house.

ANTI-McDONALD'S

Today is international actionday against McDonald's. Beside being a super-capitalist multinational company owned by yankees, McDonald's is a firm, that under-pay their employees. And McDonald's cows are grazing on areas which earlier were rainforests, but now cut down to make bigger profits to McDonald's.

We think that is outrageous. At least we must demand that McDonald's offer proper conditions to their employees, and that their cows are grazing a more suitable place than rainforests.

This is why we tonight have smashed their windows and thrown in some paint - to show we won't tolerate their filthiness."

"SOLIDARITY WITH THE PEOPLE OF EL SALVADOR - ATTACK ON UNISYS IN COPENHAGEN

The night before monday 4-12-89 we attacked the danish headquarter of Unisys, at Blegdamsvej in Copenhagen. We have painted, smashed windows and thrown in stinking acid into the offices, to disrupt their work and to show which future they deserve. In this way we show our solidarity with the fighting people of El Salvador.

Unisys is one of the biggest multinational computer firms, big supplier to the US Army. Unisys has among other things, developed and produced advanced computersystems used in the big Trident submarines and in the nuclear Pershing- and Cruise-missiles.

Beside the military job, Unisys worldwide participates in creating an alienated and computerized society, where people and life doesn't count at all. Unisys is hightechnological exploitation, oppression and death.
