When our night and weekend service is cut we'll be wondering how to get to work, home from the bar, or from church, while Kruesi and company will be pouring money into the Block 37 superstation and express trains to O'Hare and Midway. While we're struggling to survive, the CTA board is increasing their own pensions and increasing spending on the office of President Frank Kruesi.
